

I tried very hard to finish book. There is a good storyline buried in there somewhere but the jumping back and forth between characters and even timelines without notice just made it hard to read. I very rarely never finish a book even a bad book, but this one actually caused a headache.

Poorly edited and confusing. I don't want to give anything away in case the author decides to do a rewrite, so I will just say that it is painful to read. The story does not flow and his descriptions are lacking depth. It almost seems as if the author has never spent any time with children and chose to include some in his story. Many times I put this down with the intent of returning it, until it was too late. I finally managed to finish, and still think I should have returned it after the first three chapters. People should write what they know and the author clearly has no concept of what he was trying to say. The two stars is because he took the time to put words on paper.

This book bounces around and needs an editor. Very slow start as nothing happens till about 55 percent and then the standard evil terrorist are allowed to perform their deeds and of course manage to kidnap the children of the principal idiot during the middle of a CME event. Not very believable.

There are several glaring errors here. One, the town in Texas is named Big Spring, not Big Springs. And that town was founded in the 1880's, well after the Civil War, which creates a major problem for the story. There aren't heavily wooded areas in West Texas, which is also another problem. The author would be wise to do a little research if he chooses to set his novel in an unfamiliar area. It was difficult to get into this story because it was difficult to figure out what was going on. It wasn't until three quarters of the way through the story that I could kind of piece it together. Some events and actions received a lot of buildup, but then were casually abandoned. We heard so much about the impenetrable bunker, but then, the characters decided it wasn't a good sanctuary before they even tried it out. One minute, the hero was chasing terrorists who kidnapped his children, and the next, he's passed out drunk in a sleazy hotel with some woman he picked up in a bar. Despite its multiple faults, I did like this book. I found some of the characters interesting, I liked the way he put his words together, and it is a different take on the grid down/prep per storyline. The author needs to work on his craftsmanship, and he may become really good.

Some of the comments are too harsh about the writers style. I actually like the premise of the story

and yes, agree a good editor is needed. Suggest putting chronological context in the chapter titles.
