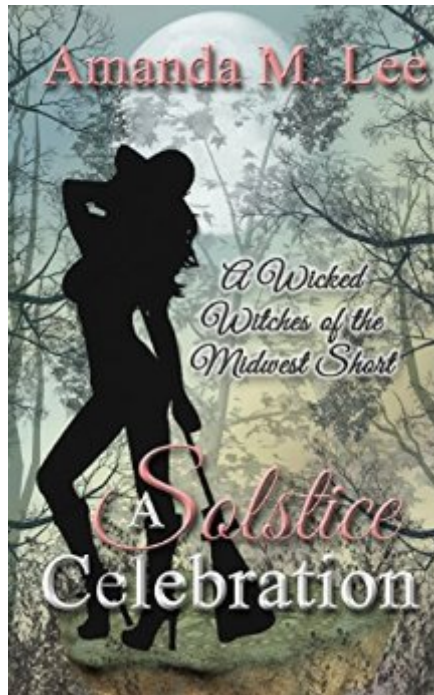


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A Solstice Celebration: A Wicked Witches Of The Midwest Short

Solstice Celebration was an entertaining short and an enlightening addition to the Series. Like the other shorts it provided a sometimes comical look back into the lives of the Winchester witches. There was quite a bit of teenage angst, high-jinx and, of course, antics by Aunt Tillie. The story was told from Marnie's Clove's mom, perspective and revolved around preparation for a summer solstice celebration while bossy Winnie was out of town. Although, overall I enjoyed the short story, I did wish that the plot had involved a bit more mystery and actual details about what happened during the celebration. However, realizing that this was after all a "short" it would have probably required that the story be longer to include the latter. *****SPOILER ALERT"

*****For the most part, I have found Aunt Tillie's antics and curses funny. However, personally, I thought that the curse involving blindness was over the top and just plain mean spirited. Moreover, to make someone blind while they are at the top of the stairs where they could have fallen and been injured or killed was heartless and simply anything but funny. If the author isn't careful she may find that there are more readers who dislike Aunt Tillie and/or think that her curses are cruel rather than funny than those who like her and/or find her antics humorous. I know that the witches, including the victims, made a joke about the incident at the end of the story but I still didn't find this particular curse funny. Maybe it's just me and I'm being over sensitive.

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
