

After asked a 2nd time I decided to proceed with a review (maybe they asked because I have actually read the entire text). 4 stars instead of 5 due to technical issues with the Kindle edition (slow, sometimes does not respond, text search very, very slow when trying to proceed through multiple pages of results). But for these issues the rating would have been 5 star. 5 star because source material is source material. This material is essential to understand Islam. While the Koran contains the word of Allah as revealed to Muhammad via communication by the angel Gabriel, the Hadith's are the sayings and doings of Islam's central human figure. In wonderful circular logic the Koran has Allah saying that Muslims should follow the "example of the prophet". That example is to be found in the Hadiths. These are the recollections of his close followers that were finally written down after his death. "The way of the prophet" if you will. The writings are also a window into the ancient world of the Arabian peninsula and provide insight into the incorporation of Pagan, Christian and Jewish influences on what came to be Islamic religious practice (the importance of the Hajj and the Kaaba being the best examples followed by claims of prophetic lineage preceded by Abraham, Noah, Moses, David and Jesus).
