

I love the characters in this series of novels. But it seemed this time they were over emphasized - especially Genevieve. She seemed more obtuse than in the last novel. There was a better explanation and balance with the technology in this novel. Being a geek, it was at least plausible. And interesting. Not just spelunking into bank accounts and personal information - which, frankly

isn't that interesting to read about even if it's interesting to actually do. The potential addition of characters to the family is nice along with the twist in what is happening in Nikki's life. Brings some humanity to the whole group and reveals more about each member in its own indirect ways. I felt the plot was lost in the characterizations. It was there. But given it was, as usual, partially based on characters from past novels, it helps to have read those books. Each novel seems to depend on a crook from the previous novel - and true to form, there is someone who escapes this time to return in a later novel. I had troubles (and this could be me) keeping track of who was who of the bad guys because the discussion of their activities were discussed in bits and pieces between discussions of the behaviors and reactions of the main characters. This interplay of the two topics in the novel is distracting. Just as you are getting into the flow and understanding what is going on in one part of the plot (for example, the criminal part) you are interrupted and find yourself back into prolonged discussions on the other part of the plot, main character personalities and foibles. It can make your head spin. If I had had a firmer grasp on the criminals and what they had each done and their clear motivations, I would have enjoyed this a great deal more.
